

2023 Stadium Heights Summer Housing Contract

Department of Residential Life: Minnesota State University, Mankato

Notice: Read all provisions of this contract before signing. You are legally bound by these Contract terms. Any exceptions to provisions contained therein must be approved by the Department of Residential Life. 1) Parties:

a) This Contract is made by and between Minnesota State University, Mankato's Department of Residential Life, and the student, referred to as Resident, signing the Contract. Minnesota State University, Mankato, and Resident, in consideration of the rents, covenants, and considerations which follow, do hereby agree with each other as follows:

2) Eligibility:

Residents of Stadium Heights Residence Community as of Friday, March 3, 2023, are eligible to stay for the summer as defined by the dates in Duration, below. Exceptions to this policy must be approved by the Director of Residential Life or their designee.

3) Duration:

- a) Subject to the provisions of **Sections 8 and 9**, this Contract is binding for the entire contract period or that portion remaining at the time Resident begins occupancy.
- b) Charges under this contract are for the period 7:00 p.m. Friday, May 5, 2023, to 12 p.m. (noon) Tuesday, August 1, 2023.
- c) The University may deny an application for university housing or terminate an existing housing contract if it determines an individual's conduct and/or criminal convictions indicate an actual or perceived threat to the University community, including residents, students, faculty, staff, and guests.

4) Premises and Services:

- a) The University agrees to assign housing in Stadium Heights Residence Community under the terms stated in the following documents which are, by reference, made a part of this document.
 - i. this Contract
 - ii. the Stadium Heights Summer Housing Application
 - iii. the Residential Life Summer Student Guide
- b) The University further agrees that it will provide a housing staff in accordance with university policy to provide a living experience that complements the academic interest of Minnesota State University, Mankato.

5) Resident Agrees:

- a) Resident agrees to abide by the terms of this Contract.
- b) Resident agrees to observe all rules and regulations of Minnesota State University, Mankato, and the Department of Residential Life as listed in the Residential Life Summer Student Guide.
- c) Resident agrees to conduct themself in a manner that allows the quiet enjoyment of the residence communities by other residents.
- d) Resident agrees to make payment of all fees as specified by the Minnesota State Board of Trustees.

6) Rates and Payment:

- Payments are due when invoiced or, if necessary, payment in installments can be arranged with Student Financial Services. Account information is available online. Bills will not be mailed.
- b) Failure of Resident to satisfy the financial obligations stipulated under this Contract will result in a hold on registration and official records and/or eviction from the residence communities.
- c) All rates are subject to change at any time due to decisions made by the Department of Residential Life, the Minnesota State Board of Trustees, or the State Legislature.
- d) Resident agrees to receive notices of housing reservations, changes, housing facility information, emergency notices, and other Residential Life information via telephone or text message to the telephone number provided in the housing application.

7) Room Assignment:

- a) The University will not discriminate in room assignment based on race, color, creed, national origin, disability, or status regarding public
- b) The University reserves the right to change room assignments for reasons of health, safety, or repair services; for disciplinary reasons caused by the Resident; or for unresolvable incompatibility of roommates.
- c) Resident may be temporarily removed from a student room if Resident is deemed a threat to the Resident's self or to the residence community. A resident so removed has recourse as described in the Residential Life Summer Student Guide.
- d) The University reserves the right to consolidate vacancies if Resident does not have a 23-24 Housing Contract.
- e) The University reserves the right to assign a summer student to any open space in any Stadium Heights apartment.

8) Contract Cancellation:

- a) Written notice of the cancellation must be provided to the Department of Residential Life according to the following schedule if Resident chooses to end this agreement.
- b) The Stadium Heights summer housing charge will be refunded if cancellation is received by the Department of Residential Life on or before 12:00 p.m. (noon) Friday, May 5, 2023.
- c) Refunds will not be given for cancellation received by the Department of Residential Life after the first day of occupancy.

9) Contract Assignment:

- a) Resident cannot transfer this Contract. Neither may Resident sublet any part of the rental premises.
- b) Contracts are not transferable from one term to another.
- c) Resident may occupy only the apartment and bedroom to which Resident has been assigned.

10) Check-in and Check-out:

- a) Resident will, upon occupying a space, complete and sign an apartment condition form, which will be a record of the apartment condition. Any damages identified at the time of check-out which were not contained on the initial apartment condition form shall be attributed to the
- Resident. The Resident is financially responsible for any such damages.
- b) Resident must check out and vacate the room/unit at the end of the contract period.

- c) Resident belongings not removed from their assigned room and apartment by the end of the contract period will be removed by Residential Life Staff, or designee, and the Resident will be billed for materials and labor associated with this service.
- d) Failure to properly check-out of the room, including an improper room change, will result in the assessment of a \$50 charge in addition to any other damage or restitution charges.

11) Maintenance:

- a) Maintenance and/or construction projects are scheduled to take place in Stadium Heights during the summer. These projects include (but are not limited to) cleaning carpets and floors, painting, bathroom inspections, plumbing projects (which may interfere with water service) and electrical projects (which may require limited power outages). Scheduled maintenance will be communicated to Resident via signs in each building.
- b) Resident may be sent or given information regarding other specific maintenance or construction projects to occur in Stadium Heights over the summer.

12) Right of Entry:

- The University, its officers, employees, and agents shall have the right to enter upon said premises at reasonable times for the purpose of routine inspection and repair; preservation of health, safety, and quietude; and when there are reasonable grounds to suspect that laws or University policies are being violated by Resident.
- 13) University Non-Liability:
 - a) The University is not responsible for damage or theft of Resident's personal property, including money. Resident is encouraged to carry appropriate personal property insurance.
- **14)** Unavailability of Premises:
 - a) In the event that any of the premises which are the subject of this Contract, which for the purpose of this provision shall include any and all areas, in and about the residence community, should be partially or totally lost, destroyed or otherwise unavailable because of fires, strikes, acts of God, or other events so as to render them unfit or unavailable in whole or in part for the purposes of the Resident, then either the University or the Resident shall have the right to immediately terminate this agreement. The University shall not be liable to the Resident for any damage occurring as the result of such termination.
- 15) Limits of Reservation:
 - A Contract for a room in a residence community does not indicate admission to the University. Conversely, admission to the University does not guarantee a Housing Contract.
- 16) Complete Agreement:
 - a) This Contract, Summer Housing Application, and the Residential Life Summer Student Guide represent the entire agreement between the parties and no oral promises between the University and Resident are binding therein. In Witness whereof, the parties have caused this Contract to be duly executed intending to be bound thereby.
